In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the hearing of the main petition is preponed from 03.02.2021 and the same is taken on board today itself.

Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid request, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within a period of 3 days from filing of such application while keeping in view the fact that challan already stands presented against the remaining accused and while also keeping in view the age of the petitioner.
