The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for protecting their civil/personal rights and liberties from being invaded by the private respondents.

Petitioner No.1 was earlier married to one Gurpreet Singh son of Chamkaur Singh and she obtained a decree of divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, vide judgment dated 29.11.2019. Minor son of petitioner No.1 is also living with her. Thereafter, petitioners solemnized their marriage on 10.11.2020.

Petitioners have already approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot /respondent No.2 by way of

representation dated 10.11.2020, which was sent through courier.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Jaspreet Kaur, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, without meaning anything in the context of validity of marriage and majority of the petitioners, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners and pass an appropriate order on merits in accordance with law. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
