Petitioner-Samiti is a society and running H.J. College of Education Palri Panihar, District Mahendergarh, Haryana for imparting education in B.Ed Courses.

Grievance of the petitioner is that the Institution/College, which was affiliated with Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind-respondent no.3 has by way of the impugned Notification dated 21.06.2017 (P-6) has along with other colleges of education situated in districts of Mahendergarh and Rewari sought to be now affiliated with Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, District Rewari-respondent no.2. Accordingly the prayer is to quash Section 4(2) of the Indira

Gandhi University, Meerpur Act, 2013 Annexure **P-4** whereby the territorial jurisdiction has been vested for exercise of powers by the University.

This Court while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 7.9.2018 had stayed the operation of impugned Notification **P-6** qua the petitioner.

This order was primarily based on a Division Bench Judgment of this Court reported as **Punjab Technical University-Non Teaching Employees Association, Jalandhar & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2016(3) S.C.T. 409.**

Subsequently vide order dated 24.09.2018 the hearing of the present writ petition was ordered to be taken up along with bunch of petitions with lead case bearing CWP No.15399 of 2017, which is listed today.

Now the applicant/Petitioner-Samiti has filed **CM No.7085 of 2020** seeking unconditional withdrawal of the instant writ petition supported by an affidavit.

Counsel for the respondents present through VC have no objection to the aforesaid request made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the contents of the application, the CM is allowed and present writ petition is hereby **dismissed as withdrawn.**
