SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner retired as Lecturer in Political Science from B.P.S. Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, Khanpur Kalan, District Sonipat-respondent No.4 on 31st August 2017. Thereafter, for a period of two years, correspondence was exchanged between the second respondent and the management of respondent No.4 regarding the eligibility of the petitioner for grant of pension. Vide communication dated 16th February 2018 Annexure P-9, respondent No.2 informed respondent No.4 that the record of the petitioner has been found in order and thus the pension case be decided in accordance with rules/policy. Thereafter, the petitioner has been making representations starting from 14th May 2019 but no action has been taken. Legal notice dated 3rd September 2020, Annexure P-20 has also not been responded to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, a direction may only be issued to respondent No.4 to decide the legal notice dated 3rd September 2020, Annexure P-20 and other similar representations by passing a speaking order.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no

necessity to issue notice to the respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the pending representations especially legal notice dated 3rd September 2020, Annexure P-20 in accordance with rules and policy and the law on the subject after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
