The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 94 dated 06.07.2020 under Sections 354, 354-A, 427, 506, 511, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 17.11.2020, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Piara Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 17.11.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
