Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 127 dated 19.07.2020 registered under Sections 324, 34 IPC (Sections 323 and 326 added later on vide GD No. 34 dated 20.09.2020), at Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has wrongly been involved in the present case. The petitioner is living in a different house. Co-accused Chamel Singh, father of the petitioner, and Rakesh Kumar, brother of the petitioner, are already on bail. A compromise has been effected between the parties. A civil litigation is pending between the parties.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, Mr. Munish Puri, Advocate, appears and files memo of appearance on behalf of the complainant through email, the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner had given three datar blows i.e. on head, back and shoulder, to the complainant.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is named in the FIR and three datar blows on the person of complainant have been attributed to him, this Court finds that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
