1. The issue which has been raised in this case is that the petitioner is claiming the validity of his certificate of registration w.e.f. 1.7.2017 instead of 26.7.2017 because it had been issued in the name of his dead father.

2. In our opinion, this is a matter which has to be decided by Union of India but none is appearing on its behalf.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Additional Solicitor General of India with Mr. Dheeraj Jain, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of Union of India and graciously undertakes to transmit a copy of this order to respondent No.1-Union of India for further action. Learned State counsel states that the reference of the State of Haryana were received late.

5. Be that as it may, we directed that this writ petition be treated as representation and respondent No.1-UOI would nominate an authorised officer who would decide the issue after hearing the petitioner and State of Haryana. Let a reasoned decision be passed thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
