Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has the instructions from the department that the prayer of the petitioner for the cancellation of transfer order dated 28.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) is already under consideration and the petitioner has not been relieved so far and the petitioner will be allowed to continue at

the station on which she is presently working till appropriate decision is taken on the representation of the petitioner.
