The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.243, dated 5th August, 2019, registered under Sections 342, 365, 395, 412, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention for almost a year since 7th December, 2019.

3. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner draws attention of the Court to the fact that his Client was not named in the FIR and that no recovery whatsoever from him was effected.

4. After completion of investigation, Challan against the Petitioner has already been submitted.

5. The trial in the case is yet to commence even the Charges have not been framed.

6. In the circumstances, without commenting upon the other merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude in view of the on-going Covid-19 Pandemic, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
