The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.87 dated 04.07.2017, under Sections 302, 201, 365 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 9-A, Gurugram.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than three years, since July, 2017.

3. Co-accused Kunal @ Golu has already been granted regular bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-40310-2019 on 18.06.2020, vide its detailed order at Annexure P-2.

4. The petitioner stands virtually on an identical footing with said co-accused Kunal @ Golu and there is no tangible/admissible material available to indicate how the nature of his involvement is more serious than

that of the said co-accused.

5. As such, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole and in view of the long detention undergone by the petitioner, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time, particularly on account of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
