This is the second petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 79 dated 10.04.2020, registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

The first petition, bearing **CRM-M-12693-2020**, was dismissed as withdrawn on 11.08.2020 as the petitioner had not joined investigation in view of direction issued on 21.05.2020 in the aforesaid petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner was not aware of any such order, which is difficult to believe for this Court as the petitioner himself had filed the said petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on merits, has argued that the marriage of the petitioner with complainant/respondent No. 2 Harjit Kaur was performed in the year 2014 and out of the said wedlock, one son, namely Amitjot Singh, was born.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the

allegations in the FIR, that petitioner and in-laws of the complainant are harassing her, for dowry are false as there is no such evidence to support the same.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail on the ground that there are direct allegations against the petitioner-husband with further allegation that petitioner has performed second marriage with a girl, namely Varkha during the subsistence of the present marriage and, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without making any comment on the merits of the case, considering the serious allegations against the petitioner, this Court finds no ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
