All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no. 2 to 4 to withdraw the investigation in FIR No. 177, dated 30.06.2020, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/328/34/498-A/506 of the IPC, from the local police, to be entrusted to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) or to a similar 'independent and impartial agency', as the local investigating agency has allegedly completely failed to carry out its duty under law and is not conducting a fair investigation.

She further seeks that a direction be also issued to the aforesaid respondents to protect her life and liberty and her family and of other witnesses acquainted with the facts of the case.

In respect of her grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Inspector General of Police, Karnal Range, Karnal (respondent no. 3 herein), a copy of which has been annexed as Anenxure P-2 with the petition (though undated), which is stated to have still not been decided.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Inspector General of Police, Karnal Range, Karnal (respondent no. 3 herein), to look into the representation of the petitioner (copy Annexure P-2) and to take action as may be warranted as per law, within a period of 3 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
