Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of her life and liberty from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 6 and respondent No.4 being her daughter-in-law is harassing her on one pretext or the other.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was being prevented to appear as a witness in case FIR No.35 of 2018, Police Station Sadar Phagwara and in this regard, a representation dated 14.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) has already been submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Phagwara.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Prabhjot Singh Walia, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book has been supplied to him in Court today.

Considering the above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Phagwara to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and take action in accordance with law, if so required.
