Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case/DDR No.35 dated 29.9.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Ropar, District Ropar in FIR No.167 dated 29.9.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and on account of sudden fight, both the sides caused injuries to each other. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is referred as wife of Lakhbir Singh, however, no specific allegation, except beating the complainant party by all the accused is levelled. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is a household lady having two minor children.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the fact that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was carrying a stick and she is not involved in any other case.

After hearing the counsel for the parties; looking into the allegations against the petitioner and also in view of the fact that no specific role is attributed to the petitioner, this petition is allowed and she be admitted to bail, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue a notice for joining the investigation, if so required.
