This is a Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are major and have got married against the wishes of their parents and relatives. They are receiving serious threats and apprehend grave danger to their life and liberty. Aadhar Cards of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively. The petitioners have also sent an application/representation dated 13.11.2020 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon (Police District), District Ludhiana (respondent No.2) for providing adequate security. However, no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. DAG, Punjab has joined the session through video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)-State.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to the veracity of the contents of the petition and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon (Police District), District Ludhiana(respondent No.2) to decide the application/representation dated 13.11.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary action as per law.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not, in any manner, be construed as an expression of opinion on the veracity of the statement made by the petitioners or on the validity of the marriage and shall have no effect on any other civil or criminal proceedings, if any, instituted/pending against them.
