The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 5.8.2020, vide which, a direction was given to the SSP to ensure the safety and security of the petitioner and to ensure that he is not put to any harassment and the issue with respect to corruption be also gone into by respondent No.3, who shall submit his report to respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Punjab.

Reply has been filed stating therein para Nos.7 to 9 as under:-

“7. That directions were also issued by the deponent to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Maur and SHO, Police Station Maur to ensure the safety and security of petitioner Ravinder Singh. Detailed report was sent to the office of Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh by the deponent vide report No.4183/lit dated 10.10.2020 in compliance of order dated 05.08.2020 pronounced in CWP No.10632 of 2020.

8. That accused Rajpal Singh son of Harbhajan Singh, resident of village Rangrial, District Mansa has also been arrested in FIR No.108 dated 10.10.2020, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC was registered at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda. Varinder Singh alias Vicky alias

Sanjay son of Janved Singh, resident of village Bangla Kheri, District Agra has also been named as accused in the above noted case vide General Diary No.22 dated 27.11.2020 of Police Station Balianwali.

9. That compliance report has also been sent to the office of Assistant Registrar (Criminal), Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh vide letter no.4230/lit dated 15.10.2020. Thus the compliance of the order dated 05.08.2020 passed in CWP No.10632 of 2020 has been made by the deponent in true letter and spirit.”

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is rendered infructuous. Dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
