LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

This petition has been filed for setting aside order dated 15.01.2018 (Annexure P-5), whereby the petitioner has been proceeded ex-parte before the Debt Recovery Tribunal-III in OA-733-2017. It is submitted that two applications had been moved before the learned Debt Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh and Recovery Officer II, Chandigarh in OA-733-2017. Applications have also been filed by the petitioner to set aside orders dated 18.09.2020 and 13.10.2020, before the Recovery Officer II, Chandigarh. However, the same were not taken up by the learned Debt Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh, due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India had been called upon to inform about the status of the working of the learned Debt Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh. It is informed by Mr. Jain, that the applications could not be listed due to certain objections, which need to be removed by the petitioner and in case the petitioner faces any difficulty, she is at liberty to contact Mr. Kartikya Verma, Registrar, Debt Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh and the matter would be taken up.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition, at this stage and pursue the matter before the learned DRT-III.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
