All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the officials respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR no.165 dated 4.10.2020, registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/365/379/506/34 of the IPC, as also take steps to recover his wife, namely, Sufia Khatoon @ Sofia @ Sonia Jaswal, who was allegedly kidnapped on 4.10.2020.

He further seeks a direction to respondents no.1 to 3 to protect his life, liberty and property at the hands of respondents no.5 and 6.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent no.2),

on 9.11.2020, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-6 with the petition.

Learned counsel submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation is decided within a specified period.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation of the petitioner, dated 9.11.2020 (Annexure P-6) and after hearing him, to take action as may be warranted as per law, within a period of 3 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
