This writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, has been filed with following substantive relief:-

“(i) Issue of order, direction or writ, especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent No.1 & 2 to immediately stop the illegal operation of bus of respondent No.3 on account of his route permit having been expired.”

Mr. Amit Jhanji, Advocate, has appeared for respondent No.3 and pointed out that the petitioner herein is respondent No.3, in CWP-3375-2014, which was admitted for regular hearing on 09.12.2019. Interim directions were also granted in favour of the respondent herein. The petitioner herein filed CM-10208-CWP-2020, for vacation of interim direction. In the aforesaid application, in para 5, the petitioner had

contended as under:-

“5. That it is worth noticing that Tarlok Singh is continuing to operate his bus even though the Bus permit No.247/R/S/89 for Jalandhar, Batala, Kartarpur, Subhanpur, Beas, Mehta one return trip has not been renewed after 23.6.2017, under the garb of stay order granted by this Hon'ble Court.”

It is apparent from the reading of the writ petition that these facts have not been disclosed in the present petition.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is apparent that the petitioner is guilty of concealment of material facts from the Court.

In these circumstances, this Court does not find it appropriate to entertain the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of above-stated order.
