ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since petitioner No. 2 Naginder Singh stands arrested, this petition may be rendered infructuous qua him.

Dismissed as infructuous qua petitioner No. 2 Naginder Singh.

After arguing for some time, finding that the Court is not convinced, learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer and submits that petitioner No. 1 may be granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed that if petitioner No. 1 moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above limited prayer, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case petitioner No. 1 surrenders before it within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of three days thereafter.
