B.S. WALIA, J. (Oral):

Learned counsel for respondenet No.6 states that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous in view of communication No.5329 dated 24.12.2019 received by him from the Secretary, Municipal Committee, Cheeka, informing decision of the Government of Haryana to take on Pay Roll those employees, who were working through agency and contractor as on 24.05.2018 and that in the light of letter of Government of Haryana memo No.14/76/2018-4CI dated 05.09.2019, Municipal Committee, Cheeka had taken on Pay Roll 44 numbers of

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Safai Majdoor and 12 numbers of fire staff. A copy of the said communication has been produced in Court, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of the relief prayed for having been granted, he does not press the writ petition and the same may be disposed of as having become infructuous while granting liberty to the petitioners to pursue the matter with the authorities for grant of consequential benefits, if any, as per their entitlement in accordance with law.

In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous while granting the liberty as prayed for.
