The issue raised in this petition is regarding alleged illegal allotment of village Depot.

According to the petitioner, the policy dated 15.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) has been violated while making the allotment inasmuch as no notice has been issued to the Panchayat and Supervising Committee nor Munadi has been done in the village. Further, resolution of the panchayat has also not been obtained.

Aggrieved by the aforementioned violations, the petitioner has already approached the Director Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab and he has issued Memo dated 01.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) to his subordinates with certain directions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the District Controller, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Hosiharpur is not heeding the aforementioned directions.

If that be the case, filing of a writ petition is not the appropriate remedy. The petitioner can approach the concerned authority who has issued

direction vide Memo dated 01.10.2020.

The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
