AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

In the light of the fact that during the pendency of the writ petition, petitioners have been promoted on attaining the qualification of B.P.Ed., the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

It may be added here that the petitioners were initially not qualified for consideration for promotion as the cut off date fixed was 21.02.2014. It is after that only, the petitioners have acquired the qualification, which would entitle them for consideration for promotion. The plea, therefore, of the petitioners with regard to the candidates, who have been promoted in pursuance to the letter dated 05.01.2015 (Annexure P-8) cannot be faulted with nor can they be granted the said benefit. However, in case the petitioner are still aggrieved, they may avail of their remedy by filing a representation to the Department, which shall consider

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and decide their claim in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of submission of such representation.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
