1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for taking action against the respondents for willfully and deliberately violating order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.12809 of 2019 in case titled as '**M/s Shri Giriraj Cattle Feed Industries, Delhi** versus **State of Punjab and others.**'

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the contempt petition as the amount claimed on account of refund has been released to the petitioner in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.12809 of 2019.

4. Ms. Deepali Puri, Advocate, who is present on behalf of respondent Nos.5 to 8, states that she has no objection if the contempt petition is disposed of as not pressed.
