This is the second petition that has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 131 dated 15.08.2020, registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 30.10.2020 passed in CRM-M-34743-2020, wherein the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of seven days and the trial Court was directed to decide his bail application within a period of three days thereafter, the petitioner could not comply with the said direction, however, he is now ready to surrender before the trial Court within a week.

In view of the above limited prayer of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioner surrenders before it within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of three days thereafter.
