The case has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners
submits that due to some typographical mistake, in para No.8
of the petition, the date of representation has been mentioned
as 10.11.2020 instead of 18.11.2020. It may be read as
18.11.2020. Ordered accordingly.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of necessary
directions to the official respondents for protecting their lives
and liberties from being invaded by the private respondents.

Petitioners are alleged to have solemnized marriage on

18.11.2020 on attaining the age of majority. They feel reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the hands of the private respondents and pray that their personal/civil rights be not violated by them.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali by way of representation dated 18.11.2020 .

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Hittan Nehra, Addl.A.G.Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

There is some shortcoming in respect of approaching the concerned authority for redressal of grievance of the petitioners. Petitioners are residents of Marari Khurd, Tehsil Majitha District Amritsar, but for their grievance they have made representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali on 18.11.2020 through courier. Be that as it may, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 by way of fresh representation. In the event of receiving such representation, respondent No.2 shall proceed to decide the same in accordance with law.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved

in any other case.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
