ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0403 dated 20.08.2020, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 & 506 IPC (Sections 452, 427, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although it is alleged that the petitioner was armed with an iron rod but no specific injury is attributed to him. He further contends that the injuries, which were received by the injured, were simple in nature except one injury which was found to be grievous. He also contends that the grievous injury is attributed to the co-accused Chander Sagar @ Gharonda. The petitioner is in custody for a period of two months since his arrest on 28.09.2020.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, contends that the matter is under investigation.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when no specific injury is attributed to him, he is in custody for over two months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
