The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') praying for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0045 dated 02.07.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations, as contained in the FIR, allegedly

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the petitioner raised lalkara and gave *dasti dang* blow on wrist of left arm of the complainant namely Paramjit Singh. Initially the FIR was registered under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and thereafter on the basis of the report based upon the MLR, Section 326 IPC was added.

On 20.11.2019, interim protection was granted to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying with the provisions contained in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Abdesb Singh, states that in pursuance of order dated 20.11.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process. He further states that the petitioner is no longer required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of above stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed. Interim order dated November 20, 2019, is hereby made absolute.

Since the main relief has been granted, misc. application is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.
