1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel contends that CWP No.24039 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur, to consider and decide representation dated 25.06.2019, in accordance with law, within 06 weeks of receipt of certified copy of the judgment and in case, the competent authority concluded that the request of the petitioner was justified, then consequential benefits were to be released within 06 weeks thereafter, but in case, the competent authority was of the view that the request made by the petitioner was not justified, a speaking order was required to be passed, however, needful had not been done, therefore the instant contempt petition had been filed for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful disobedience of orders dated 03.09.2019 in CWP No.24039 of 2019.

3. Issue notice to the respondent to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated

against him for non-compliance with orders dated 03.09.2019 in CWP No.24039 of 2019.

4. Ms. Deepali Puri, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has produced copy of speaking order dated 21.10.2019, rejecting the claim made in representation dated 25.06.2019. Order dated 21.10.2019 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that he does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 21.10.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed*** as withdrawn, with the liberty, as prayed for.
