Short reply filed on behalf of the respondent is taken on record.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present contempt petition with a direction that from henceforth the directions shall be followed in letter and spirit and in case on any particular fixed day, the child cannot be sent with the grandparents, prior information at least three days in advance shall be communicated to the grandparents on their whatsapp numbers. The respondent shall show some compassion towards the grandparents, who are senior citizen and not harass them mentally by making flimsy excuse for not sending the children in compliance with the directions of this Court. Next time, this Court may have to take serious note.

Disposed of in the above terms.

Parties are also directed to strictly comply with the directions of this Court.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
