Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner was rejected on the ground of limitation. However, during the pendency of writ petition, the examination bye-laws have been amended and limitation has been extended to five years. Thus, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to make a fresh representation on the basis of the amended examination bye-laws.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
