The prayer of the petitioner in this case was to direct the Bhakra Beas Management Board, to re-employ him on contractual basis as an Assistant Engineer (OP) at Ganguwal, Kotla, District Ropar.

However, perusal of the office order dated 6.6.2014 of the Board, demonstrates that such re-employment on contractual basis can only be extended to the retired employees, in spells of one year, upto the maximum age of 62 years.

The petitioner, as on date, is over the age of 62 years. He would therefore not come within the ambit of the Board's Policy for re-employment of retired employees.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed on this short ground.
