The petitioner society has filed this petition being aggrieved by rejection of its technical bid for the tender issued by respondent No.1 for allotting the sanitation work. It is submitted that the petitioner who has been doing this work for respondent No.1 for the last several years has been declared ineligible in the tender proceedings without informing the petitioner of the reasons for doing so and inspite of the fact that the petitioner was found to be technically compliant in the previous four tenders issued by respondent No.1 for the same work. It is, however, observed that the petitioner has directly approached this Court without filing any representation in this regard before the respondent-authorities.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-authorities that in case the petitioner filed a representation within three days along with a copy of the petition and copy of the order passed today, the concerned authority of respondent No.1 shall consider and take a decision thereon and inform the decision in writing to the petitioner within two weeks thereafter.

As the petition has been disposed of ex-parte, the respondents, if aggrieved, would be at liberty to move an application seeking review of the order.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
