1. Result of the petitioner No.1 in BCA category, petitioners No.2 & 3 in General category and BCA category while result of petitioner No.4 in General category for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/ DHBVNL, against Advertisement No. 3/2016, category No. 3 has been produced in sealed cover(s) in Court alongwith cut-off marks obtained by the last selected candidate in the respective categories. Result on opening reveals the petitioners to have secured following marks as against 57/92 marks of the last candidate selected in BCA category and 113/117 marks of the last candidate selected in General category in UHBVNL/DHBVNL:

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the marks obtained by the petitioners which are more than the marks obtained by the last selected candidate in the respective category, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action, in accordance with law.

3. Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action on the result of the petitioners in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

5. Writ petition disposed of in the afore-mentioned terms.
