Case has been taken up through video conferencing in view of the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

2. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of Regular Bail to the petitioner in Case FIR No.75 dated 29.06.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

3. The petitioner has remained in detention in this case for three months since 02.09.2020.

4. After completion of investigation, challan was filed against him.

5. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the fact that his client has not been named in the original FIR, and even

otherwise assuming him to be one of the unidentified persons accompanying the culprits, still no actual injury has been attributed to any such unidentified person.

6. Considering all the above circumstances and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, and in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
