The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No.27 dated 28.05.2019 under Sections 324, 326, 506, 354, 148 and 149 IPC recorded in FIR No.209 dated 31.12.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar Commissionerate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 24.10.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sudesh Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.10.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
