This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the detainee, namely, Jaswinder Kaur from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued on 17.08.2019. In response to the petition, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Amarjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jalalabad, District Fazilka on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to counsel opposite. In the reply, it is mentioned that the alleged detainee, namely, Jaswinder Kaur is
