Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the time of filing of the writ petition, the petitioner was not aware that the examination bye-laws have been amended and a limitation of five years has been prescribed for change in the particulars of the secondary school examination certificate. The claim of the petitioner was rejected on the ground of limitation alone. During the pendency of the writ petition, a fresh representation dated 10.7.2018 has been filed based upon the amended examination bye-laws and thus, at this stage, he prays for direction to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to decide the said representation within a limited time frame, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 10.7.2018, expeditiously, in accordance with law, keeping in view the amendment introduced on 10.11.2017 and in any case, not later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
