Case has been taken up through video conferencing in view of the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

2. This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioners in case FIR No.491 dated 20.06.2020, under Sections 323, 307, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Panipat, District Panipat.

3. The petitioners have remained in detention in the present case for more than three months since 04.08.2020.

4. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the

petitioners have already been submitted. As such, he is not required for the purpose of investigation. Moreover, co-accused-Azad has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide **CRM-M No.37686-2020** passed on 19.11.2020.

5. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioners and the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, as such, the prayer of the petitioners for their release on regular bail is allowed and they are ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
