Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner Inderjit Singh has brought the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India against respondents i.e. State of Haryana, State of Punjab, SSP, Patiala, Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, SHO, Police Station Sector 14, District Panchkula, Incharge, Police Post, Sector 16, Panchkula and Head Constable Jaspal Singh, Police Post, Sector 16, Panchkula for issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty and take legal action against respondents No.5 and 6 i.e. Incharge, Police Post, Sector

16, Panchkula and Head Constable Jaspal Singh, Police Post, Sector 16, Panchkula for illegally picking up the petitioner and detaining him at police post without any reason and giving beatings to him.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 4 and 5 and Mr.H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.4 – Commissioner of Police, Panchkula is directed to consider the representation Annexure P2 dated 14.10.2020 submitted by the petitioner and take necessary action in the matter.

Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana submits that the respondents No.1, 4 and 5 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.4 – Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to consider the representation Annexure P2 and to take necessary action in the matter, in accordance with law if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case, expeditiously.
