Present petition has been filed under Article 227 of Constitution of India seeking direction to the official respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide security to the petitioners who are apprehending danger to their lives at the hands of respondents No.2 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the present case all the three petitioners are children of respondent No.3 Sarabjit Kaur and they are apprehending danger at the hands of their own mother namely, Sarabjit Kaur. Since she has dispute with their father with whom they are living, there is a strong apprehension that the mother by way of all unlawful methods will take the custody of them from their father. He has further submitted that petitioners No.1 and 2 are minors and they are in the custody of the father whereas petitioner No.1 is 19 years old girl who wishes to stay only with her father. He has submitted that representation

vide Annexure P-1 was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh as well as to the incharge Police Post 61, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh on 17.11.2020 but no action has been taken by them and that there is a grave threat to the petitioners as aforesaid.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepinder Singh Brar, APP, UT, Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the UT – respondents No.1 and 2 and submits that UT, Chandigarh has no objection in case direction is issued by this Court for the disposal of the representation Annexure P-1.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider the representation Annexure P-1 in accordance with law and take appropriate action in case it is so required.
