RAJAN GUPTA, J. (Oral)

The petitioners have sought a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to fulfill their statutory obligation of carrying out external development work including construction of 24 meter wide road in Sector 102, Gurugram as per final development plan and shifting of the cremation ground.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.3 and 4 has produced a communication which he received from the concerned Estate Officer, according to which, 75 meter and 60 meter wide sector dividing roads around Sector 102, Gurugram have already been constructed.

However, no land has been acquired for development of 24 meter wide

internal road. As per its stand, further development of road including 24 meter wide internal road has to be taken care by Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority. Same has not been impleaded as party in the present writ petition.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary as 75 meter and 60 meter wide road has already been constructed by HSVP, Gurugram. The petitioners are at liberty to make a representation regarding the grouse if any subsists to Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority.
