This petition has been filed by the petitioner assailing the constitutional validity of the scheme framed by the respondents vide notification dated 29.10.2020. Apparently the petitioner's remedy is before the Central Administrative Tribunal and therefore, in view of the decision of the Supreme Court in *L.Chandra Kumar v. Union of India and others 1997(3) SCC 261*, specifically the law laid down in paragraph-93 therein, the petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Central Administrative Tribunal for mitigation of her grievances and assailing the validity of the scheme.

Disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.

Looking to the background of the petition, it needs no emphasis to state that the Tribunal, when approached, shall take up the matter at an early date.
