The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 10.07.2019 under Sections 306 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 17.10.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Even the investigation is complete and Challan has been presented in the Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Narinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
