Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in a complaint case bearing No. 62-2 dated 07.04.2017 registered under Sections 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is on bail in case bearing FIR No. 48 dated 06.02.2020 under Section 174-A IPC registered at Police Station Siwani, Bhiwani. Though the amount involved in the present case is Rs. 1,23,000/-, yet learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to pay an amount of Rs. 50,000/- to the complainant at this stage, within one week of his appearance before the learned trial Court.

Keeping in view the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the notice is not being issued to the respondents, as it would unnecessary delay the proceedings before the learned trial Court.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate and subject to the payment of Rs. 50,000/- to the complainant, within one week of his appearance before the concerned Court.

It is made clear that if the above said condition is not complied with, this order shall stand cancelled automatically.
