The petitioners, 19 in number, seek regularization of their services in the Education Department of the State of Haryana. They claim to have rendered several years of service but assert that they have not been granted relief despite others similarly situated being regularized in service. They place reliance on the order dated 17.01.2020 passed by this Court in **CWP-37236-2019**, titled '**Kiran Pal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**'.

Perusal of the aforesaid order dated 17.01.2020 demonstrates that the authorities were directed thereby to consider the claim of the petitioners therein in the light of the relevant instructions/policy pertaining to regularization of services. As the petitioners stand identically situated

and the legal notice dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-7) gotten issued by them in this regard still remains unaddressed, no cause is made out for this Court to entertain the present writ petition for adjudication on merits. The authorities concerned need to apply their mind to the issue in the first instance and take a decision.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondent-authorities to consider the claims of the petitioners for regularization of their services in terms of the policy extant, duly taking note of the contents of their legal notice dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-7). This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
