This petition has been filed by the applicant-wife seeking transfer of a petition filed by her husband under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 bearing GW No.42 of 2019 titled as "Gurmeet Singh v. Jasmine Kaur" pending in the Court of Additional Princiapl Judge, Additional Family Court, Gurugram to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is residing with her mother who is a widow. One girl child born out of the wedlock is in the custody of applicant. She has no source of income. It is very difficult for her to travel 125 kms from Panipat to Gurugram on each and every date of hearing.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the case.

4. Indisputably, minor child of the parties is residing with the applicant at Panipat. Section 9(1) of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 provides that the jurisdiction to try such application vests with the Court where the minor ordinarily resides.

5. In the premise, present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of Additional Principal Judge, (Additional Family Court), Gurugram is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to District Judge, Panipat for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.

6. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
