Petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to consider their cases for regularization as they are part time employees and have fulfilled the qualifications prescribed for regular Class-IV employees in the Haryana State, Secondary Education Field Officers (Group-I) Services Rules, 1998.

The petitioners are working in various capacities as Peon/Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar/Water Carrier being Class-IV employees since 2005-2007. Particulars of one of the petitioners have been placed on record as Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the judgments passed by this Court in Gopal Singh vs. State of Haryana and others, CWP No.32932 of 2019, decided on 15.11.2019 (Annexure P-5) and Kiranpal and others vs. State of Haryana and others, CWP No.37236 of 2019,

decided on 17.01.2020 (Annexure P-6), whereby direction was given to the

respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner (therein) for regularization.

With regard to their grievance, petitioners got served a legal notice dated 03.07.2020 (Annexure P-7) upon the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider the case of petitioners as per instructions dated 25.02.1999, 11.11.2003 & 27.02.2004 (Annexure P-2, P-2A and P-2B) and pass a final/speaking order on the legal notice dated 03.07.2020 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If, the petitioners are found entitled to the above said benefit, appropriate order be passed within next one month. In case, no order is passed within the stipulated period, costs of Rs.25,000/- shall be paid to the petitioners.
