Petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to count their service rendered on daily wage basis as Special Police Officers (SPOs), towards qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the issue has already attained finality as per the judgment passed by this Court in Harbans Lal vs. The State of Punjab and others, CWP No.2371 of 2010, decided on 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-4) and subsequent judgments passed in Sukhjeet Singh and others vs. The State of Punjab and others, CWP No.9936 of 2017 (decided on 15.02.2018) & Jarnail Singh & others vs. State of Punjab & others, CWP No.7127 of 2019, decided on 01.04.2019 (Annexures P-7 and P-8). With regard to their grievance, petitioners got served a legal notice dated 28.09.2020 (Annexure P-11) upon the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice dated 28.09.2020 (Annexure P-11) and pass a speaking order thereon in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If, the petitioners are found entitled to the above said benefit, same shall be released/extended to them within next four weeks.
