The petitioners are retired employees. They were not granted benefit of adhoc service and, thus, they approached this Court by way of a writ petition. The same was allowed and the benefit was granted. However, ACP Grade has not yet been granted. Even representation dated 01.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) and legal notice dated 17.09.2020 (Anenxure P-4) have failed to move the respondents.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity of filing a written statement.
